 Clean, crisp and fresh apple and yeasty aromas.

**28: Champagne Barfontarc Rose** £39.95  
 A lovely salmon pink in colour, with delicious, juicy candied fruit flavours.

**29: Joseph Perrier Cuvée Royale Brut Champagne** £46.95  
**FRANCE** A bright, salty lemon aroma with some lime and white pepper. A nice mousse with lots of fresh, seaside elements with an underripe pear flavour.
